REGION	Margaret River
HARVEST	20th April 2016
TASTING	Intense blackberries, cassis and a dusting of cocoa on the nose. Abundant dark berries, black olive and cedary oak merge with fine tannins to create an elegant wine with a long finish.
VARIETY	Cabernet 100%
WINEMAKING	Small batches of the best fruit were hand plunged. Matured in 50% new French oak for 14 months.

“ There is more new wood on this cuvee, bridling greater intensity of flavours and ageworthiness. Hand plunged, before spending nine-months in French barriques, this is a pointed cabernet of well alloyed ball-bearing tannins melding with the cedar oak spice to coat the mouth. Behind lies currant, pastille, olive and bay leaf, to be liberated further with time in the cellar. This is excellent. ”

HARVEST 12th April 2016

TASTING Aromas of bright boysenberry, blood plums and liquorice. Classy oak adds mocha and spice to palate that's bursting with luscious fruit. Medium bodied with soft tannins and a lingering finish.

VARIETY Shiraz 100%

WINEMAKING Best fruit selected and hand plunged. Matured in 50% new French and Hungarian oak for 14 months.

“More oak on this as the moniker ‘Reserve’ so often implies. It doesn’t work as well as the cabernet of the same tier, but boasts a density of fruit and intensity of flavour that copes with it reasonably well. Blue fruits, a telltale skein of pepper grind acidity, iodine and a bulwark of cedar-vanillin oak. Time will attest to the capacity of this wine to grow in stature. At this stage, I much prefer the Single Vineyard cuvee.”
